Shaping the Local Energy Future – Together!

In Bavaria, municipal utilities met at an exchange hosted by Civic Foundation Energiewende Oberland to tackle energy transition challenges.

Key insight: Energy Communities and energy sharing are true game changers. They empower citizens, strengthen resilience, and are already technically feasible. What's still missing? Clear frameworks and smart meters to fully unlock their potential.



Gabrovo pioneers Bulgaria's Energy Communities

The Municipality of Gabrovo has emerged as a real pioneer, now home to two of Bulgaria's five registered Energy Communities. By uniting citizens, businesses, and institutions, the city is creating affordable and sustainable energy models—proving that local action sparks nationwide change.

Why is this important?

Energy Communities are not just about technology – they provide a path to energy independence, social solidarity, and a better quality of life for everyone.



Energy Communities on the Agenda at Maribor Business Breakfast

At a business breakfast hosted by the Štajerska Chamber of Commerce, ENERGAP presented how Energy Communities can lower electricity bills and boost energy independence. About 22 company representatives joined the event, part of POWER-E-COM's European training programme. Discussions focused on new grid tariffs, legal frameworks, and successful case studies. The session sparked lively debate and networking, showing how businesses can play a leading role in the green transition.



Webinar on Energy Communities in Europe

On 29 April 2025, POWER-E-COM and the LIFE ISLET project hosted a webinar on what drives successful Energy Communities. Experts from across Europe shared insights on future visions, best practices, island experiences, and EU-level support. The event underlined the importance of collaboration and clear frameworks for empowering communities in the energy transition.







POWER-E-COM at the EirGrid Energy Citizens Roadshow

POWER-E-COM participated in the EirGrid Energy Citizens Roadshow in Cashel, meeting local people and community groups. The team shared ideas on citizen-led energy and listened to community concerns.

Experts including Seán Kelly (ESB Network), Gearóid Fitzgibbon (SEAI), Matthew Staunton (EirGrid Group), and Clare Lee (Tipperary County Council) provided valuable insights on grid operations and community supports. The event highlighted the importance of collaboration between citizens, experts, and local authorities. Together, these efforts are paving the way for a more sustainable and community-driven energy future.



Agri-PV in Action: Energy and Farming Hand in Hand

In Peissenberg, Bavaria, our German partner Civic Foundation Energiewende Oberland hosted a study visit to one of the region's most innovative Agri-Photovoltaic (Agri-PV) installations.

Developed by the local cooperative Energiegenossenschaft Oberland eG, the system shows how renewable energy and agriculture can thrive together on the same land.

The event gathered representatives from politics, farming, energy, and local communities to see first-hand how Agri-PV not only generates clean electricity but also improves soil protection and microclimate conditions. A great example of the energy transition in action!
